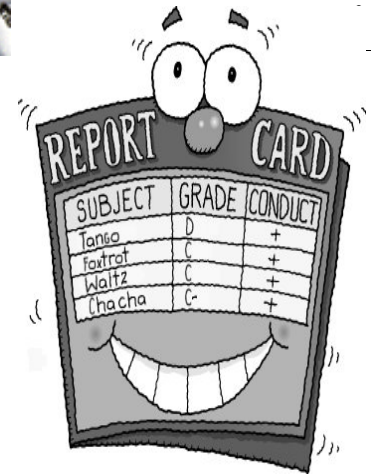
Soccer Try Outs
